The University Transportation Study Committee (TSC) met on Monday, February 28, 2005 at Facilities Planning and Construction Division, 232 Stadium West Conference Room. Linda Dixon, Chair, presided and called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

### **I. Welcome and Introductions – Linda Dixon**

After welcoming members to the UF Transportation Study Committee (TSC) meeting Ms. Linda Dixon, chair, introduced herself to the committee and asked the committee members to introduce themselves.

### **II. Adoption of Agenda**

### **IV. Archer Road Sub-Area Study**

Mr. Joe Corradino met with the TSC members to discuss some of the issues that affect the Archer Road and SW 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue location both from a land use and transportation standpoint, and to seek input from committee members regarding this study. Mr. Corradino distributed the Scope of Work to committee members for them to review at their leisure. He stated that it basically involved generating alternatives to serve the area. Alternatives ranging from the typical approach of highways to significant emphases on transit and then a combination of the two to see how they can make the area more friendly for those who visit and work in medical facilities in the area.

Mr. Corradino asked for suggestions and recommendations from committee members regarding the proposed project. Members discussed various issues including parking, bicycle and pedestrian access, garage access, transit, safety, and funding. Mr. Corradino will return to the committee in April/May timeframe to present draft alternatives.

**V. Activity Center and Structured Parking Opportunity Sites Analysis**

The TSC members continued the discussion of the draft maps depicting ten major activity centers, four minor activity centers and eleven structured parking opportunity sites presented by Ms. Linda Dixon at the January 24, 2005 TSC meeting for committee members recommendations and approval. Ms. Dixon stated that the MPSC committee approved this proposal with the addition of two structured parking opportunity sites for analysis in the surface parking garage at the O'Connell center and the commuter lot on Gale Lemerand Drive.

Committee members also discussed potential off-campus structured parking locations north of University Avenue, east of SW 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and south of Archer Road.

**Motion:** Bob Miller made a motion to approve the proposed Activity Center and Structured Parking Opportunity Sites as amended with the two additional structured parking opportunity sites at the O'Connell Center and Commuter Parking lots.
